## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

The *Canberra Institute of Technology Act 1987* (the Act) and the *Financial Management Act 1996* provide for the establishment and appointment of the governing board members.

This instrument appoints Jane Madden to be CIT Board Deputy Chair until 31 August 2026, commencing the day after notification.

This instrument makes an appointment to which the *Legislation Act 2001*, Division 19.3.3, applies and is a disallowable instrument. The Minister for Skills, Training and Industrial Relations has consulted with the Standing Committee on Economics, Industry and Recreation regarding the appointment. The committee made no comment on the appointment.

Jane Madden has expertise and knowledge in international business development and relations, governance, vocational education and training and audit and risk.

Jane Madden has not been appointed to the Board as the CIT staff or student member representative.

Jane Madden is not an ACT public servant.

This instrument revokes Jane Madden's current appointment as a Member of the CIT Board.
