EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Overview

This explanatory statement relates to the *Road Transport (General) Numberplate Fees Determination 2025 (No 5)* (the **instrument**) as presented to the Legislative Assembly. It has been prepared to assist the reader of the instrument. It does not form part of the instrument and has not been endorsed by the Assembly.

Section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* (the **Act**) permits the Minister to determine fees, charges and other amounts payable under the ACT road transport legislation.

This instrument determines fees for transactions relating to vehicle numberplates and the rights to registration numbers issued under the road transport legislation.

This instrument revokes the *Road Transport (General) Numberplate Fees Determination 2025 (No 4)* (DI2025-242) (the **revoked instrument**). This instrument corrects a typographical error. No changes of substance have been made, further to those listed in the revoked instrument, and no existing fees and charges in this determination were increased.

This instrument commences on the day after its notification day.

This determination under section 96 of the Act is a disallowable instrument and must be presented to the Legislative Assembly within 6 sitting days after its notification pursuant to *Legislation Act 2001* (the **Legislation Act**), section 64.

Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS)

A RIS is not required for this fee determination due to section 36 (1) (a) of the Legislation Act, which provides that a RIS need not be prepared for a matter that is not of a legislative nature, for example, a matter of a machinery, administrative, drafting or formal nature.
