## **EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The *Building and Construction Industry Training Levy Act 1999* establishes the Building and Construction Industry Training Fund Authority (the Authority) that is responsible for administering the fund and making payments, or directing that payments be made, from the fund in accordance with training plans.

Section 6 of the *Building and Construction Industry Training Levy Act 1999* establishes the composition of the Building and Construction Industry Training Fund Authority Governing Board.

Section 78 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* enables the Minister to make appointments of governing board members generally. Section 79 of the *Financial Management Act 1996* enables the Minister to appoint a chair or deputy chair to a governing board.

This instrument appoints Jim Corrigan as the Chair of the Board, for a term of three years from 1 January 2026.

The appointee is not a public servant and the determination is a disallowable instrument for the purpose of division 19.3.3 of the *Legislation Act 2001*.

The Legislative Assembly Standing Committee on Standing Committee on Economics, Industry and Recreation were consulted and have no objections to this appointment.
