Casino Control Act 2006, section 143 (Determination of fees)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Casino Control Act 2006* (the Act) regulates the operation of the casino in the Territory.

This instrument revokes the determination of fees made by Disallowable Instrument DI2025-104, the *Casino Control (Fees) Determination 2025*.

Section 143 of the Act provides that the Minister may determine fees for the Act. This instrument provides for fees in relation to administrative tasks performed under the Act, including matters relating to the casino licence and applications for casino employee's licences and variations to these licences.

The new determination sets the fees that will apply beginning on 1 July 2026 and repeals the *Casino Control (Fees) Determination 2025* DI2025-104. Fees in the 2026- 2027 financial year have been generally increased from fees in the previous financial year by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 3.25% plus an additional 0.35%, rounded down to the nearest dollar. Some smaller value fees may be rounded up to the nearest dollar. This approach also aligns with the *Fees and Charges Policy and Guidelines 2026 - 2027*.

The list of items for which fees are set in this instrument is identical to the list of items in Disallowable Instrument DI2025-104.

Explanatory notes in the attachment list the fees previously determined to enable comparison.
