

# Lotteries (Fees) Determination 2026

## Disallowable Instrument DI2026–89

made under the

**Lotteries Act 1964, section 18A (Determination of fees)**

## EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

---

The *Lotteries Act 1964* (the Act) provides for the approval and regulation of lotteries in the Territory.

Section 18A of the Act provides that the Minister may determine fees for the Act. Fees were previously determined by the ACT Gambling and Racing Commission. The *Justice and Community Safety Legislation Amendment Act 2021* amended the Lotteries Act to provide that fees were determined by the Minister, to make the Act consistent with other gaming legislation. This instrument provides for fees in relation to applications to the Gambling and Racing Commission for approval to conduct lotteries in the Australian Capital Territory.

The new determination sets the fees that will apply beginning on 1 July 2026 and repeals the *Lotteries (Fees) Determination 2025* DI2025-105. Fees in the –2026 - 2027 financial year have been generally increased from fees in the previous financial year by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 3.25%, plus an additional 0.35%, rounded down to the nearest dollar. Some smaller value fees may be rounded up to the nearest dollar. This approach also aligns with the *Fees and Charges Policy and Guidelines 2026 - 2027*.

Clause 5 of the instrument provides for the refund or waiver of fees. Clause 5(1) provides that if an application under section 7 of the Act for approval to conduct a lottery is withdrawn before assessment, the fee, less \$76.00 is refundable. The previous determination provided that the fee, less \$74.00 was refundable.

The new instrument does not change the types of fees that may be charged in comparison to the revoked instrument.

### Human Rights

The Standing Committee on Justice and Community Safety (Legislative Scrutiny Role) terms of reference require consideration of human rights impacts, among other matters. In this case, no human rights are impacted.
