

Co-operatives National Law (ACT) (Fees) Determination 2026

Disallowable instrument DI2026-103

made under the

Co-operatives National Law (ACT) Act 2017, schedule 1 (Modifications – Co-operatives National Law)

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Minister has power to determine fees for the purposes of this Act.

The new determination sets the fees that will apply beginning on 1 July 2026 and repeals the *Co-operatives National Law (ACT) (Fees) Determination 2025* DI2026-118. Fees in the 2026 - 2027 financial year have been generally increased from fees in the previous financial year by the Wages Price Index (WPI) of 3.25% plus an additional 0.35%, rounded down to the nearest dollar. Some smaller value fees maybe rounded up to the nearest dollar. This approach also aligns with the *Fees and Charges Policy and Guidelines 2026-2027*.

Explanatory notes in the determination list the fees previously determined to enable comparison.
