BLOOD DONATION (TRANSMITTABLE DISEASES) ACT 1985

NEW DONOR DECLARATION

INSTRUMENT NO. 36 OF 1999

- (1) The Instrument of Approval has been prepared in accordance with section 5.(1) (a) of the *Blood Donation (Transmittable Diseases) Act 1985*.
- (2) Section 5 (1)(a) of the *Blood Donation (Transmittable Diseases) Act 1985* specifies that:
- "For the purposes of sections 3 and 4, the prescribed requirements, in relation to the taking of blood from a donor, are
- (a) that, before taking blood from the donor, the Society obtains from the donor a declaration in accordance with a form approved by the Minister by instrument in writing published in the Gazette;"
- (3) The ACT Branch of the Australian Red Cross Blood Service now has a nationally endorsed Donor Declaration, developed by the Australian Red Cross Blood Service Donor and Product Safety Committee.
- (4) The ACT Australian Red Cross Blood Service will implement the use of the new Donor Declaration on 1 March 1999.
