

Government Procurement (Non-Public Employee Member) Appointment Revocation 2026 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2026–193

made under the

***Government Procurement Act 2001*, section 33 (Board members–appointment)**

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The *Government Procurement Act 2001* (Act) establishes the Government Procurement Board (Board), with the responsibility for reviewing and making recommendations on procurement issues, procurement proposals and activities undertaken by territory entities subject to the *Government Procurement Regulation 2007* (Regulation).

Section 33 of the Act relevantly enables the Minister to appoint members. Section 228(1) of the *Legislation Act 2001* specifies that the Minister’s power to make an appointment includes the power to end an appointment.

Under section 229 of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the appointment instrument is a disallowable instrument. Under section 208(2) of the *Legislation Act 2001*, the instrument to end the appointment is exercisable in the same way and subject to the same conditions as the power to make the appointment.

This revocation is made by the Minister for Finance.
