DETERMINATION OF FEES AND CHARGES

DETERMINATION NO. 5 OF 1995

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This Determination of Fees and Charges revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees and Charges No. 3 of 1994, dated 20 January 1994, and notified in Special Gazette No S11 on 21 January 1994.

The Determination comes into effect on the date of gazettal and increases the fees as follows:

Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations – Registration of barbers shop	\$72.00	\$74.00
Public Health (Boarding-houses) Regulations – Registration as proprietor	\$72.00	\$74.00
Public Health (Piggeries) Regulations – Registration of piggery	\$72.00	\$74.00
Public Health (Dairy) Regulations – Licence as dairy producer	\$70.00	\$74.00
Public Health (Dairy) Regulations – Registration of dairy herd	\$70.00	\$74.00

A 3.0% adjustment for the expected CPI increase during the current financial year was endorsed by the Government as part of the 1994–95 annual review of fees and charges. This adjustment increases the fees from \$72.00 to \$74.00 per annum.

The two fees under the Dairy Regulations were inadvertently missed when adjusting the fees for the 1994 calendar year. The increase in 1995 reflects an adjustment from \$70.00 to \$74.00 to regain parity with other fees levied under the Public Health Act.
