EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Nature Conservation Act 1980 ('the Act) protects native animals and plants in the ACT, allows for the monitoring of the trade in native and exotic species of flora, fauna and fish and allows for the regulation of activities in reserves and wilderness areas.

Under section 83A of the Act the Minister may determine fees. This Determination revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets fees for the grant of licences under the Act. Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index. New fees for the grant of licences under section 27 of the Act have been introduced.

The licences and fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees.
