NO. 83 OF 1995

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This determination revokes all existing fees determined under the *Dangerous Goods Act 1984*, namely Determination No. 60 of 1994 notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S125 of Monday 27 June 1994.

This determination sets fees for the purposes of the *Dangerous Goods Act 1984* and has the effect of increasing fees payable for the issuing and renewal of a licence for the keeping, transporting, manufacturing or importing of dangerous goods into the ACT.

The fees have may show slight variances due to rounding off, but are in line with the CPI increase of 4%.

The fees for this Determination, which take effect from 1 July 1995, are show below with the existing fees in brackets.
