DETERMINATION NO. 104 OF 1997

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Dangerous Goods Act 1984 regulates the transport, storage and manufacture of dangerous goods. This determination revokes all existing fees determined under the Dangerous Goods Act 1984, namely Determination No 185 of 1996 as notified in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No S202 of 15 August 1996.

This determination sets fees for the purposes of the Dangerous Goods Act 1984 and has the effect of increasing fees payable for the issuing and renewal of a licence for the keeping, transporting, manufacturing or importing of dangerous goods into the ACT.

The fees may show slight variances due to rounding, but are in line with the CPI increase of 1.75%.

The fees for this Determination, which take effect from 1 July 1997, are shown in the table below with the existing fees in brackets.
