

**AUSTRALIAN CAPITAL TERRITORY
VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING ACT 1995
DETERMINATION OF FEES**

DETERMINATION NO. 114 OF 1997

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Vocational Education and Training Act 1995 commenced operation on 1 January 1996. The Act provides for planning, funding, co-ordination, evaluation, regulation and promotion of vocational education and training in the ACT.

Section 67 of the Act provides for fees to be determined for the purposes of the Act.

The fees for 1997-98 have increased from the existing 1996-97 fees by the Consumer Price Index at 1.75% as advised by the Office of Financial Management and five new fees introduced.

Under the previous Vocational Training Act 1989 registration fees were paid as part of the administrative arrangements. The Registration of Training Provider and Additions to Provider Scope fees are required under the Vocational Education and Training Act 1995, Section and 18 (2) (b) which states 'An application will be accompanied by a determined fee'.

The Registration of Training Provider and Additions to Provider Scope fees have continued to be levied by the ACT Vocational Training Authority but now both fees need retrospective determination from 1 January 1996 and determination from 1 July 1997 under Section 67 of the new ACT Vocational Training Act.

No training provider would be disadvantaged from this action. Under Section 18 (2) (b) of the Vocational Education and Training Act 1995 as stated above, a training provider that does not pay the fee would not be registered under the Act. Training providers that have paid the retrospectively determined fee would be registered under the Act.

The Registration of Training Provider fees are to be increased from the retrospectively determined rate of \$500 00 by CPI to \$509.00.

The Additions to Provider Scope fee involves the registration of additional courses or changes to courses. This process involves further site visits and is proving to be time intensive and thus incurring additional expense. The proposed increase in this fee from \$100 to \$150 is considered to better reflect the actual resources used in the process.

The new Recognition Services fees are planned to cover costs associated with the introduction of regulatory and audit arrangements that underpin the Quality Framework introduced on 4 February 1997. This process is a nationally agreed audit process that is a more rigorous and extensive system than there has been in the past.

Note: The term 'Recognition Services' is a term introduced by the Australian National Training Authority and is in common usage in the training industry. Recognition Services by definition is a generic term for accreditation, registration, skills recognition, recognition of prior learning and quality management in the vocational education and training sector. Self Assessment Validation is a registration process. Registration under Self Assessment Validation and as an Endorsed Quality Provider and Quality Registration Documentation are registration processes that relate to Section 19 of the Act.
