DETERMINATION OF FEES

NO. 141 OF 1997

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Liquor Act 1975 governs the sale and consumption of liquor in the ACT. Section 105A of the Act enables the Minister to determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

This Determination revokes Determination of Fees No. 101 of 1996 dated 25 June 1996 and published in the Australian Capital Territory Gazette No. S136 of 26 June 1996 and determines new fees for the purpose of the Act.

The fees have generally been increased by 1.75% in line with the anticipated movement in 1997/98 of the Consumer Price Index. The permit fee is not changed as it is the same as the fee payable under the Business Franchise (Liquor) Act 1993 which is to remain unchanged next financial year. The fee for the issue of a proof of age card is not changed. A statement of the old and new fees is hereunder.
