WATER POLLUTION ACT 1984

REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

DETERMINATION NO. 182 OF 1997

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Water Pollution Act 1984 ('the Act') controls the pollution of the waters in the Australian Capital Territory. Under section 39 of the Act the Minister may determine fees.

This determination revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets fees for the grant of licences under the Act. Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The licences and fees payable for the purposes of section 19 of the Act are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees

Storm water run-off laden with silt, soil, earth, mud, stones, clay, colloids, organic matter or other like material, being run-off caused by the disturbance of the land surface during the process of land development

Where the area of the premises specified in the application is:

- (1) less than 1Ha \$360.00 (\$355.00)
- (2) 1Ha or more but less than 2Ha \$580.00 (\$570.00)
- (3) 2Ha or more but less than 5Ha \$940.00 (\$920.00)
- (4) 5Ha or more but less than 20Ha \$1 550.00 (\$1 520.00)
- (5) 20Ha or more \$2 360.00 (\$2 320.00)

All other discharged waste

When the maximum quantity of waste to be discharged in one day is:

- (1) less than 100 kilolitres \$1 000.00 (\$985.00)
- (2) 100 kilolitres or more but less than 1 megalitre \$1 150.00 (\$1 135.00)
- (3) 1 megalitre or more but less than 10 megalitres \$1 340.00 (\$1 320.00)
- (4) 10 megalitres or more but less than 50 megalitres \$4 120.00 (\$4 045.00)
- (5) 50 megalitres or more \$5 580.00 (\$5 485.00)

Where the discharge of waste is likely to take place on less than three consecutive days and not more than two events in a licence year:

- (1) less than 100 kilolitres per day \$240.00 (\$240.00)
- (2) 100 kilolitres per day or more but less than 1 megalitre per day \$280.00 (\$275.00)
- (3) 1 megalitre per day or more but less than 10 megalitres per day \$330.00 (\$320.00)
- (4) 10 megalitres per day or more but less than 50 megalitres per day \$600.00 (\$590.00)
- (5) 50 megalitres per day or more \$810.00 (\$800.00)
