REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

INSTRUMENT NO. 14 OF 1998

This instrument made under section 9A of the Roads and Public Places Act 1937 (the Act) revokes the existing Determinations of Fees and sets the fees for the purposes of sections 15E and 15K of the Act.

The purpose of the fee is to allow builders to use unleased Territory land for storage and other purposes under a short term licence arrangement during the construction of a development

All fees have increased as a result of CPI adjustments in accordance with Government policy.
