PESTICIDES ACT 1989
REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF FEES
DETERMINATION No. 88 of 1994
EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Under section 83 of the Pesticides Act 1989 ('the Act'), the Minister may determine fees. This Determination revokes the existing Determination of Fees and sets fees for registration of pesticides which are available for purchase and use in the ACT and issuing of restricted, research and emergency permits for the use of pesticides in the ACT.

Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees.

The fee which must accompany an application for the registration of a pesticide	\$100.00 (\$97.00)
The fee which must accompany a notice, where there are no labels also accompanying the notice	\$11.00 (\$11.00)
The fee which must accompany a notice, where there are labels also accompanying the notice:	
(a) in respect of the first 10 labels accompanying the notice and any number up to 10	\$56.00 (\$54.00)
(b) in respect of each label in excess of 10 accompanying the notice	\$11.00 (\$11.00)
The fee which must accompany an application for a restricted permit	\$23.00 (\$22.00)
The fee which must accompany an application for renewal of a restricted permit	\$23.00 (\$22.00)
The fee which must accompany an application for a research permit	\$56.00 (\$54.00)
The fee which must accompany an application for the renewal of a research permit	\$56.00 (\$54.00)
