EXPLANATORY STATEMENT


Under Section 10 of the Racecourses Act 1935 ('the Act') the Minister may, by notice in the Gazette, determine fees for the purposes of the Act.

Under the Act the Minister may upon payment of the prescribed fee, issue a racecourse licence. The Act specifies that a race meeting shall not be held at any racecourse unless it is licensed under the Act.

Fees payable under the Act have been reviewed and increased generally in line with the Consumer Price Index.

The fees are set out below, the amounts in brackets are the previous fees.

- (a) the fee payable for the purposes of Section 7 of the Act is \$75.00 (\$70.00); and
- (b) the fee payable for the purposes of Section 7A of the Act is \$75.00 (\$70.00).
