PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989

DETERMINATION NO. 120 OF 1994

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, Land and Planning.

The attached Schedule of the Determination, together with the accompanying map, details the origin and significance of the new street names.
