**PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989**

**DETERMINATION NO. 123 OF 1994**

**EXPLANATORY STATEMENT**

The Public Place Names Act 1989 provides for the naming of divisions and in particular, section 4 empowers the Minister, by notice published in the Gazette, to determine the name of a division or public place.

Pursuant to section 5 of the Administration Act 1989 the Minister has delegated the power under the Public Place Names Act 1989 to name a division or public place to the Secretary of the Department of the Environment, Land and Planning.

Section 27 of the Interpretation Act 1967 specifies that where an Act confers a power on a person to make an instrument then, unless the contrary intention appears, that person has the further power to revoke that instrument.

This determination amends Determination No 4 published in Gazette No S12 of 21 January 1994 by omitting two street names in the division of Amaroo.
