Electoral Act 1992

Appointment of Electoral Commissioner

The Electoral Act 1992 provides for elections of members of the Legislative Assembly and related matters.

Subsection 22(1) of the Electoral Act 1992 states that the Executive may, by instrument, appoint a person to be the Electoral Commissioner.

This instrument appoints PHILLIP CHARLES GREEN, as the Electoral Commissioner of the Australian Capital Territory Electoral Commission for a period of five years.
