PUBLIC HEALTH ACT 1928

DETERMINATION OF FEES No. \exists OF 1994

This Determination of Fees revokes and replaces the Determination of Fees No. 159 of 1992 dated 27 October 1992 and notified in Special Gazette No. S187 on 30 October 1992.

This Determination comes into effect on the date of gazettal. It increases the fees as follows:

Regulations	Present <u>Fee</u>	New <u>Fee</u>
Public Health (Barbers' Shops) Regulations	\$70.00	\$72.00
Public Health (Boarding-houses) Regulations	\$70.00	\$72.00
Public Health (Piggeries) Regulations	\$70.00	\$72.00

A 3.0% adjustment for the expected CPI increase during the current financial year was endorsed by the Government as part of the 1993–94 annual review of fees and charges. This adjustment increases the fees from \$70.00 per annum to \$72.00 per annum.

Fees for dairymen and dairies, dairy herds, eating houses, meat vendors and prepared meat goods previously determined under the Public Health Act are now determined under the Food Act 1992.
