MOTOR OMNIBUS SERVICES ACT 1955
REVOCATION AND DETERMINATION OF CHARGES
NO. 24 OF 1996

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

This instrument revokes all existing determinations under the Motor Omnibus Services Act 1955, namely Determination No 76 of 1995 dated 27 June 1995 notified in the Australian Capital Territory Special Gazette No S155 of 29 June 1995, and sets new charges for the purpose of the Motor Omnibus Services Act 1955 as listed in the Schedule to the Determination.

This instrument also introduces new ticket types and updates the definitions for concession and other travellers. New ticket types introduced are 4-ride and single-ride FareGo tickets and a range of stored value tickets for special events services. Changes to definitions have been made to:

- reflect the inclusion of concession passengers in a child/student group or a pensioner/beneficiary group - resulting in a more consistent entitlement to concessions (eg unemployed persons and their spouses now receive the same level of concession),
- delete redundant definitions of sightseeing and long distance sightseeing services - special fares no longer apply on these services,
- delete the redundant definition of student nurse - this is now encompassed by the definition of tertiary student, and
- define special events services to facilitate the introduction of prepurchased tickets for these services.

This instrument removes the requirement that child/student travellers on commuter express services pay an adult fare.

Details of charges applying are listed in the table below. These are the same as those in Determination No 76 of 1995 except for the introduction of the new fares types.
