EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

The Agents Board is a body corporate constituted under the *Agents Act 1968* and reports to the Minister for Business, Employment and Tourism.

The role of the Board is to act as the licensing authority for the real estate and travel industries in the ACT. In discharging this function, the aim of the Board is to ensure that consumer interests are protected.

The composition of the Board is determined by the Act. The Board consists of seven members all of whom are appointed by the Minister. Members are appointed for periods up to three years as part-time statutory office holders.

This instrument (copy attached) appoints Mr Peter Crowley as a member of the Board (section 9 (2) of the Act) and as Chair of the Board (section 10 (1) of the Act).

The Instrument of Appointment was prepared following consultation with the Legislative Assembly Committee nominated by the Speaker, as required by the Statutory Appointments Act 1994.
