ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS

- I, Rosemary Follett, Chief Minister for the Australian Capital Territory-
 - (a) pursuant to section 43 of the Australian Capital Territory (Self-Government) Act 1988 of the Commonwealth-
 - (i) allocate to a Minister referred to in the first column of the Schedule matters relating to the powers of the Executive as follows:
 - (A) the responsibility of governing the Territory with respect to the matters specified in the second column of the Schedule opposite the reference to that Minister; and
 - (B) the responsibility of executing and maintaining the enactments specified in the third column of the Schedule opposite the reference to that Minister, and the subordinate laws made under those enactments; and
 - (ii) authorise any Minister to act on my behalf or on behalf of any other Minister,
 - (b) pursuant to section 54 of that Act-
 - (1) divide the public service into the administrative units referred to in the fourth column of the Schedule,
 - (ii) place the Head of Administration in control of the administrative unit or units referred to in the fourth column of the Schedule opposite the reference to the Head of Administration in the fifth column of the Schedule and
 - (iii) place an Associate Head of Administration referred to in the fifth column of the Schedule in control of the administrative unit or units referred to in the fourth column of the Schedule opposite that reference; and
 - (c) pursuant to subsection 6 (2) of the Public Service Act 1989 of the Territory-
 - (i) allocate to a Minister referred to in the first column of the Schedule responsibility for the administrative unit or units referred to in the fourth column of the Schedule opposite that reference; and
 - (ii) allocate to an administrative unit referred to in the fourth column of the Schedule responsibility for-
 - (A) the matters referred to in the second column of the Schedule opposite that reference; and
 - (B) the enactments referred to in the third column of the Schedule opposite that reference.
