
STOPFORD CRESCENT

James STOPFORD Queensland Politician and (1878-1936) Trade Unionist.

Fitzroy Delegate to the 1910 Labor-in-Politics convention. Won Labor seat of Mount Morgan in Legislative Assembly in From 1932 to his 1915. death held Maryborough. Parliamentary career also included Chairman (1918) to the Public Works Committee; Home Secretary in 1923-29; Secretary for Mines and 1932-36.
