CONSUMER AFFAIRS ACT 1973

CONSUMER PRODUCT SAFETY ORDER

WHEREAS I am satisfied that the making of a consumer product safety order in relation to self-loading centre fire rifles of a military type and anything which substantially duplicates such a rifle in design, function or appearance is reasonable and necessary to prevent or reduce the risk of injury to, or impairment of health of, persons arising out of the possession, handling or use of those goods by those persons or any other persons.

NOW THEREFORE I, TERENCE CONNOLLY, Attorney General, in pursuance of section 15FC of the Consumer Affairs Act 1973, make a consumer product safety order that the supply of self-loading centre fire rifles of a military type and anything which substantially duplicates such a rifle in design, function or appearance be prohibited in the Australian Capital Territory.
