#### LIQUOR ACT 1975

#### DETERMINATION No.115 of 1992

Under section 12F(1) of the Liquor Act 1975 I REVOKE the determination of fees, notice of which was published in the ACT Gazette No.12 on 27 March 1991.

I DETERMINE that with effect from 15 August 1991 an appointed member of the Liquor Licensing Board shall be paid the following remuneration and allowances:

Office Daily fee

Chairperson \$240

Member \$194

#### Travelling Allowance as follows:

- (a) if a chairperson of the Board, at the Sydney rate of \$230 per overnight stay, other capital city rate of \$190 per overnight stay, or the other than capital city rate of \$145 per overnight stay;
- (b) if a member of the Board, at the same rate payable to the chairperson of the Board.

# REMUNERATION AND ALLOWANCES FOR APPOINTED MEMBERS OF THE LIQUOR LICENSING BOARD

The Liquor Licensing Board is established pursuant to section 12A of the Liquor Act 1975 (the Act).

The functions of the Board are:

- (a) to consider and determine applications or other matters referred to it under the Act;
- (b) to conduct inquiries, including hearings, in relation to applications or other matters referred to it under the Act;
- (c) to advise the Minister, as required, on matters of policy and administration; and
  - (d) to perform such other functions and duties as are conferred on it by or under the Act or another Act.

Under section 12F of the Act the appointed members of the Liquor Licensing Board are entitled to remuneration and allowances at a rate determined by the responsible Minister.

On 9 March 1991 the former Attorney General determined pursuant to the Remuneration Tribunal, Fees and Allowances - Offices Not Specified Determination, the Category 2 daily fee be paid to members of the Liquor Licensing Board.

In Determination Number 22 of 1991 the Remuneration Tribunal determined new daily fees for Offices Not Specified, Category 2 to take effect from 15 August 1991.




