CITY AREA LEASES ACT 1936

INSTRUMENT OF APPROVAL UNDER SECTION 10

Under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 I CARL JAMES THOMPSON APPROVE of TREVOR LESLIE BESWICK ("the Applicant") carrying on the profession trade occupation or calling of PHYSIOTHERAPIST ("the business") on Block 4 Section 54 Division of FLYNN known as 59 SPALDING STREET FLYNN ("the land") subject to the following conditions relating to the use of the land being observed by the Applicant in carrying on the business -

- that this approval will remain valid only while the Applicant continues to be a bona fide resident of the land;
- 2 that the Applicant will ensure that the conduct of the business does not cause an annoyance a nuisance or danger and is not offensive to any tenants or occupiers of adjoining lands;
- that the Applicant will not erect or permit or suffer to be displayed or erected upon the land or any building thereon any advertising sign or hoarding whatever without the consent in writing of the Australian Capital Territory Planning Authority and the Building Controller;
- 4 that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly in accordance with the application made by the Applicant under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 unless otherwise stipulated in this Instrument;
- that no person other than the Applicant will conduct or in any way carry on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;


