Notification of intention to commence building,

excavation or compressed air work

- a) in the case of work, in relation to a single private dwelling-house
- \$9.00 for every \$1 000.00 or part thereof by which the cost of the work exceeds \$250 000.00
- b) in the case of work not being building work in relation to a single private dwelling house:
 - (i) where the cost of the work exceeds \$20 000.00 but does not exceed \$200 000.00
 - (ii) where the cost of the work exceeds \$200 000.00
- \$9.00 for every \$1 000.00 or part thereof the cost of the work exceeds \$20 000
- \$900.00 together with \$1.15 for every \$1 000.00 or part thereof by which the cost of the work exceeds \$200 000.00
