CASINO CONTROL ACT 1988

Under section 80(2) of the Casino Control Act 1988, I HEREBY SPECIFY the following periods within which a cheque shall be presented for payment by the casino licensee:

- (i) for cheques drawn on a bank account located at a Branch within Australia, a period of 5 (five) working days from the date of the receipt of the cheque by the casino licensee and
- (ii) for cheques drawn on a bank account located at a Branch outside Australia, a period of 20 (twenty) working days from the date of the receipt of the cheque by the casino licensee.

CASINO CONTROL ACT 1988

DETERMINATION

Under section 3(1) of the Casino Control Act I HEREBY DETERMINE that the class of persons set out below are not to be operations employees:

any person who is employed or permitted to work in relation to any activity which does not involve:

- (i) the conduct of gaming;
- (ii) in relation to gaming, the movement of money or chips about the casino;
- (iii) in relation to gaming, the exchange of money or chips to patrons in the casino;
- (iv) in relation to gaming, the counting of money or chips in the casino;
- (v) the operation and storage of gaming equipment in the casino;
- (vi) the supervision of any of the above activities;
- (vii) the unsupervised maintenance or repair of gaming equipment in the casino or
- (viii) casino security.
