
## SCHEDULE 'A'

## DIVISION NAMES WITH REFERENCE TO ORIGIN

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE/REMARKS
GUNGAHLIN	'Gungahlin Homestead'	Gungahlin Homestead; built in 1862. Sold to Edward Kendall Crace in 1877 and remained in the family until it was resumed by the Commonwealth for the Federal Territory. The Homestead site is listed on the Register of the National Estate.
