A Board of Inquiry was held by the Medical Board of the Act, on the 12 October 1992 into the conduct of Dr Raymond Kwi Chan of 16/108 Reserve Road Artarmon NSW.

The purpose of this inquiry was to consider the conduct of Dr Chan which led to his deregistration from the provisions of the ACT Medical Practitioners Registration Act 1930 Section 30(2)(A). The Board must hold an Inquiry into an ACT registered medical practitioner whose registration has been suspended/cancelled by another Australian State/Territory Medical Board.

The findings of the Board of Inquiry were that the rights of Dr Chan to practise in the Australian Capital Territory as a medical practitioner be cancelled as from 10 November 1992.




