

NOISE CONTROL ACT 1988

EXEMPTION NOTICE

No.001/95

Under Subsection 16(2) of the Noise Control Act 1988, I exempt, EXHIBITION PARK IN CANBERRA from the provisions of section 12 of the Noise Control Act 1988 between the hours of 10:00am and 6:00pm on the 29 JANUARY 1995 in respect of noise emitted from motorsports events to be conducted at Exhibition Park in Canberra on Flemington Road, Mitchell in the Australian Capital Territory.

Provided that the emitted noise level shall not exceed 20 dB(A) above the background noise level at the nearest and/or most affected residence.

Subject to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989, an application may be made to the Administrative Appeals Tribunal for a review of the decision to which this notice relates.

Except where subsection 26(11) of the Administrative Appeals Tribunal Act 1989 applies a person whose interests are affected by the decision may request a statement pursuant to Section 26 of the Act.
