

NATIONAL EMPLOYER SATISFACTION SURVEY. T95098

The Australian Committee on Vocational Education and Training Statistics (ACVETS) is a cooperative endeavour of relevant Commonwealth/State agencies to collect and report on management and statistical information relating to vocational education and training (VET) in Australia. ACVETS wishes to appoint a suitably qualified organisation to undertake in 1995 a national survey to gauge employer satisfaction with training.

The survey will seek employer views and recent experience of VET specifically its availability, relevance and quality. The sample of employers will need to cover all national industry groupings and all States and Territones. The survey will need to collect details on the workplace and industry of employees, training available and undertaken, perceived relevance of training and outcomes in the workplace.

The consulting organisation will be responsible for developing a suitable methodology for collecting information on employer satisfaction with VET, the survey design, administering the survey to employers, tabulating and analysing the information collected, and evaluating and reporting on the results. Options for the survey methodology could include mail questionnaires, personal or telephone interviews, focus group discussions or any combination of these. The survey reference period is expected to be August 1995, with final reporting on the survey results in
