INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.11 FOR TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT IMPROVEMENTS ON LEARMONTH DRIVE, VANSITTART CRESCENT AND BODDINGTON CRESCENT, KAMBAH

ACT Capital Works has submitted to the ACT Planning Authority an Implementation Plan for traffic management improvements on Learmonth Drive, Vansittart Crescent and Boddington Crescent, Kambah.

The proposal is for the construction of traffic control devices such as centre blisters, speed humps, road narrowing, modified tee junctions and slow ways at various points and intersections along Learmonth Drive, Vansittart Crescent and Boddington Crescent, Kambah.

These traffic calming proposals have been discussed with residents, as well as other interested parties, at public meetings conducted by Traffic and Roads Section.
