Request for Tender ACTSA 205 Provision of a Day Program for Young People in Substitute Care who are not in the School System

The Family Services area of the Children's, Youth and Family Services Bureau is responsible for the care and protection of children at risk of abuse and/or neglect in the ACT Community, including the provision of appropriate day time activities to enable children in the substitute care system to maximise their developmental opportunities

Family Services is seeking tenders from suitably qualified and experienced community based agencies to provide a skills development course for young people who are in a substitute care placement and who are not in the education system. The program would be designed to meet the needs of young people, aged 13-16, referred by Family Services, who are alienated from the school system
