INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.22 FOR THE WATSON DOWNER TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SCHEME

The Construction and Management Maintenance Service of the Department of Urban Services has submitted to the ACT Planning Authority an Implementation Plan for the Watson Downer Traffic Management Scheme.

This Scheme involves the installation of:

- two Roundabouts on Knox Street in Watson;
- one Roundabout, and possibly another, on Melba Street in Downer; and
- raised pavement platforms on Briggs, May, Shirley, Cadell, Gale, Pigot and Swindon Streets in Downer.

Copies of the Implementation Plan are on display, until 9 February 1996, at Clarkes Butchery Windeyer Street Watson, and on the Community Notice Board, Downer Square, Downer. The Plan may also be inspected at the Shopfront, John Overall Offices, 220 Northbourne Avenue, Braddon, during normal business hours.
