INVITATION TO COMMENT ON IMPLEMENTATION PLAN NO.27 FOR FORREST STORMWATER AUGMENTATION (YORK PARK INFRASTRUCTURE STAGE 3B)

The Construction and Management Maintenance Service of the Department of Urban Services has submitted to the Metropolitan Planning and Land Supply Branch an Implementation Plan for Forrest Stormwater Augmentation (York Park Infrastructure Stage 3B).

This Implementation Plan involves the construction of an underground stormwater drainage system with associated side entry pits and junction manholes. Pipe diameters will vary from 300mm to 600mm within verges and from 1200mm to 1800mm within road pavements.

Works within the verges will be adjacent to the kerb and gutter, requiring a trench width of 1 metre maximum, whilst major drains will be located beneath the road carriageway.

Works will take place within the suburb of Forrest in National Circuit, Hobart Avenue, Dominion Circuit, Arthur Circle, Tasmania Circle, Barkly Crescent, Wilmot Crescent, Tennyson Crescent, Nares Crescent, Baudin Street and Moresby Street.

A concurrent Development Application for Heritage Approval has also been advertised for public comment in the Classified Section in Saturday's edition of the Canberra Times.
