DRAFT VARIATION NO.76 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN AREA SPECIFIC POLICY - PALMERSTON SECTION 142 BLOCKS 7 & 8 SECTION 143 BLOCKS 8 & 9

The Planning and Land Management Group of the Department of Urban Services is inviting comment on draft Variation No.76 to the Territory Plan for an Area Specific Policy for Section 142 Blocks 7 & 8 and Section 143 Blocks 8 & 9 in Palmerston.

Draft Variation No 76 proposes to vary the Residential Land Use Policies in the Territory Plan Map and Written Statement to provide for the development of five dwellings for aged persons on Blocks 7 & 8 Section 142 and five dwellings for aged persons on Blocks 8 & 9 Section 143 of Palmerston.
