DRAFT VARIATION NO.82 TO THE TERRITORY PLAN - PROPOSED AREA  
SPECIFIC POLICIES B11 AND B12 IN NORTH CANBERRA AND NEW URBAN  
HOUSING CODE

The Planning and Land Management Group of the Department of Urban Services has undertaken a review of the policies in the Territory Plan for the "B1 - Three Storey Development" area in North Canberra

Draft Variation No.82 to the Territory Plan has resulted from this review and proposes to provide for two new Area Specific Policies identified as "Area B11 Urban Housing (generally three storeys)" and "Area B12 Urban Housing (maximum two storeys)". These policies would replace the existing B1 policy for selected parts of inner North Canberra

The draft Variation also proposes a new Urban Housing Code, which would apply to the area and would replace the existing B1 Guidelines and the Design and Siting Code for Multi-Dwelling Development at Appendix III 2 of the Plan, for the purposes of assessing applications for redevelopment within the B11 and B12 areas

The area concerned is shown on the map below
