Wood (Prepared), Wood Products and Furniture (Except Sheet Metal) and Mattresses (Except Rubber) (09)

Paper, Paper Products, Printing and Publishing (10)

#### Chemicals, Petroleum and Coal Products Refined or manufactured (11)

Adhesives, ammunition; cosmetics; fireworks; soaps, rubber, pesticides, paint; petrol

#### Non-Metallic Mineral Products, Manufactured (12)

Glass, clay and ceramic products; cement, concrete, plaster and stone products

#### Basic Metal Products, Manufactured (13)

Iron and steel sheets, rail fastening, chains, steel castings; pipe fittings; refined and smeltered products, rolled, drawn and extruded metal products

#### Fabricated Metal Products (14)

Hand tools, carports, fly screen doors; metal sheds; cans, sheet metal furniture, cutlery, springs, bolts

#### Transport Equipment (15)

ACT Corrective Services seeks expressions of interest from suitably qualified individuals and organisations to deliver community based programs that effectively address the criminogenic needs of offenders on community corrections orders using intervention strategies that aim to

- Prevent violent behaviours for about 30 people per year
- Prevent further sex offending for about 20 people per year
- Achieve pro-social cognitive change for about 50 offenders per year (ie problem solving, self control skills, changing attitudes towards offending etc)

Those on the program will be non-voluntary and will face possible court action if they fail to comply

Programs may combine individual based interventions or rely on group work techniques (or a combination of the two approaches). All proposals must be accompanied by evidence that proposed strategies have been previously shown to reduce offending and must include an evaluation framework which conforms with basic scientific design principles.

Proposals from students studying towards post graduate degrees will be considered if they are supervised by the academic institutions at which they are studying
