**Draft Contaminated Sites Environment Protection Policy
Call for Public Comment**

The draft Contaminated Sites Environment Protection Policy (the EPP) contains information and policies relating to the assessment and remediation (including management) of contaminated land. It aims to minimise the risk of adverse impacts of contaminated land on the environment and human health.

The EPP explains the procedures that the Environment Management Authority will use to manage contaminated land in the ACT and provides guidance on the obligations of owners and occupiers of contaminated land to meet their legislative requirements.

The EPP is available for public comment until 16 May 2000
