Under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act 1936 I CARL JAMES THOMPSON APTROVE of STS-NE WILLIAM JITIS ("the Applicant") carrying on the profession trade occupation or calling of AUDIOLOGISI ("the business") on Block 9 Section 10 Division of DEAKIN known as 16 NORTHCOTE CRESCENT DEAKIN ("the land") subject to the following conditions relating to the use of the land being observed by the Applicant in carrying on the

- that the Applicant will not erect or permit or suffer to be displayed or erected upon the land or any building thereon any advertising sign or hoarding whatever without the consent in writing of the Interim Territory Planning Authority and the Building Controller;
- that the Applicant will conduct the business strictly in accordance with the application made by the Applicant under section 10 of the City Area Leases Act unless otherwise stipulated in this Instrument;

- that no person other than the Applicant will conduct or in any way carry on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;
- 6 that the Applicant will ensure that all residence and business related vehicles are parked within the confines of the land;
- 7 that the Applicant will not employ any more than one assistant for the purpose of conducting or carrying on the business on the land without the prior approval of the Minister;
- 8 that only 2 bedrooms in the house be used for the conduct of the business;
- 9 that the business will only be conducted on the land between the hours of 9.00 am and 6.00 pm Monday to Friday and 9.00 am and 12.00 noon Saturdays;
- that the Applicant well conduct the business structly by appoint wat, and that cach appointments well be organised to ensure that cooms the conduct are in attendance at any one time;
- If that this approval will torminate on the thirtieth day of November 1990 or on such entline date as the Minister determines in accordance with condition 12;
- 1! upon any failure to comply with any or all of the foregoing conditions the Himselet or his Delegate under the said Act may give written notice requiring the Applicant to show cause within a period of fourteen days why this approval should not be revoked. At the expiration of this period the Himselet or his Delegate may revoke the approval.
