If you believe the party should not be registered:

- . because it does not have as an object the promotion of the election to the Legislative Assembly of candidates it has endorsed; or
- . because the application does not meet the technical requirements of the Act; or
- . because its name (or abbreviation) is likely to be confused with that of another registered party,

you can formally object by submitting in writing the reasons for that belief. Your submission, which must be signed and contain your address, should be lodged with the Australian Electoral Commission, West Block, Queen Victoria Terrace (Box E201 Queen Victoria Terrace PO, Canberra ACT 2600) by Wednesday 18 July 1990.
