DECLARATION

Under Section 4 of the Noxious Weeds Act 1921, I REVOKE all previous Declarations declaring a plant to be a noxious weed; and

I DECLARE the following plants to be noxious weeds:

Hemlock	(<i>Conium maculatum</i> L.)
Indian Hemp	(<i>Cannabis sativa</i> L.)
Opium Poppy	(<i>Papaver somniferum</i> L.)
Paterson's Curse	(<i>Echium plantagineum</i> L.)
Saffron Thistle	(<i>Cirsium lanatum</i> L.)
St John's Wort	(<i>Hypericum perforatum</i> L.)
Star Thistle	(<i>Centaurea calcitrapa</i> L.)
Sweet Briar	(<i>Rosa rubiginosa</i> L.)
Serrated Tussock	(<i>Nassella trichotoma</i> (Nees) Hackell)
Scotch Thistle	(<i>Cnicus acanthium</i> L.)
Illyrian Thistle	(<i>Cnicus illyricum</i> L.)
