The Australian Electoral Commission has received the following application for registration of a political party under the *Australian Capital Territory (Electoral) Act 1988*.

The application states that the party wishes to receive public funding as reimbursement of campaign expenditure.

If you believe the party should not be registered:

- . because it does not have as an object the promotion of the election to the Legislative Assembly (of the ACT) of candidates it has endorsed; or
- . because the application does not meet the technical requirements of the Act; or
- . because its name (or abbreviation) is likely to be confused with that of another registered party,

you can formally object by submission in writing to the Australian Electoral Commission. Your submission, which must be signed and contain your address, should be lodged with the Australian Electoral Commission, West Block, Queen Victoria Terrace (Box E201 Queen Victoria Terrace PO, Canberra ACT 2600) by Wednesday 3 October 1990.
