***Notice of application to register a political party***

The Australian Electoral Commission has received the following application for registration as a political party under the *Australian Capital Territory (Electoral) Act 1988*.

The application states that the party does not wish to receive election funding in reimbursement of campaign expenditure.

If you believe the party should not be registered:

- . because it does not have as a purpose, the promotion of the election to the Legislative Assembly (of the ACT) of candidates it has endorsed; or
- . because the application does not meet the technical requirements of the Act; or
- . because its name (or abbreviation) is likely to be confused with that of another registered party,

you can formally object by writing to the Australian Electoral Commission. Your submission, which must be signed and contain your address, should be lodged with the Australian Electoral Commission, Box E201, Queen Victoria Terrace PO, ACT 2600, by 24 April 1991.
