  - (iii) "Racecources Act 1935"

from the third column and inserting in that column opposite and in relation to "Minister for Sport":

- (iv) "Betting (Totalizator Administration) Act 1964"; and
- (iii) "Racecources Act 1935"

- (f) deleting:
  - (i) "Australian Capital Territory Gaming and Liquor Authority (Repeal) Act 1990";
  - (ii) "Bookmakers Act 1985";
  - (iii) "Lotteries Act 1964";
  - (iv) "Pool Betting Act 1964"; and
  - (v) "Unlawful Games Act 1984"

from the third column and **inserting** in that column opposite and in relation to "Treasurer" references to those Acts and:

- (vi) "Games Wagers and Betting-houses Act 1901 (NSW);
- (vii) "Gaming and Betting Act 1906 (NSW)"
- (g) deleting "Motor Traffic (Alcohol and Drugs) Act 1977 from the third column and inserting a reference to that Act in the third column opposite and in relation to "Minister for Urban Services"
