
**PUBLIC ROADS ACT 1902 OF THE STATE OF NEW SOUTH WALES

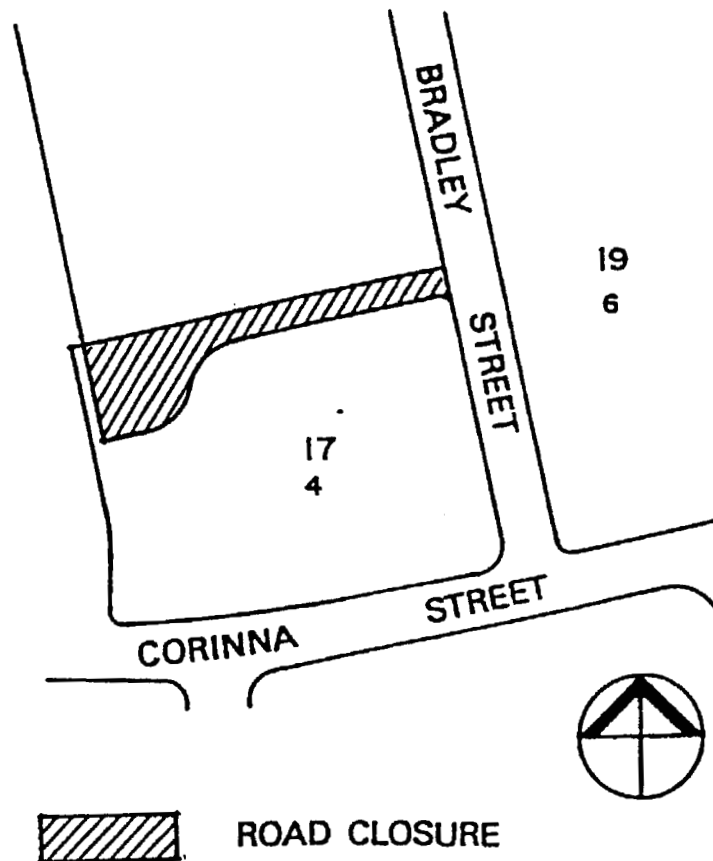


All that land in the Australian Capital Territory, shown hatched on the plan annexed hereto:
